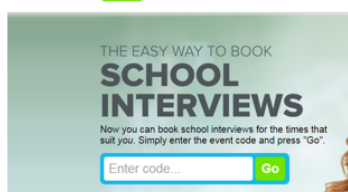

IMPORTANT:

Buses:

If you are looking to move outside your current bus route, we recommend that you contact the office as soon as possible, availability on other buses is not guaranteed.
