Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) At Onewhero Area School

At Onewhero Area School we recognise the necessity of arming our students with digital skills. As citizens of the 21st century the use of Digital Technologies is an integral part of daily living for most of us.

School is unable to provide necessary digital access without employing a BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) policy. Our students need to have access to digital resources in a seamless manner in our classrooms.

Our school is a BYOD school for years 3-13. We recommend Chromebooks for all students from Years 3 to 13. However students in Years 11 to 13 who are in digitally demanding subjects (Graphics and Digital Technologies) will also need access to a PC at home, or to a laptop with an i5 processor or better.

In 2018 we began a partnership with Harvey Norman to supply Chromebooks to whanau of Onewhero Area School. This process is continuing in 2020 with a new range of Chromebooks available. [Please see here for the options](#)
